



Daily Schedule

Our Day begins upon arrival of the first child and ends upon departure of the last child each day. Children will be encouraged but will not be forced to participate in any activity.

- 8:30 am** **Breakfast - Those who would like to eat breakfast are given healthy options**
- 10:00 am** **Circle Time - Children will be given an opportunity to share any news or special experiences. During this time, we will sing interactive songs such as “The ABC’s”, “Wheels on the Bus” and “Five Little Monkeys”. We will also discuss the day of the week, the month, the year and the weather. We also have flashcards that the children love!**
- 10:30 am** **Group activity time – Children can participate in our morning activity. This may involve arts & crafts, science & discovery, games, puzzles etc. Some days this will be a planned activity based on our theme or skill focus. Other days children will be given materials to work on their own creations. As we finish our activity the children will move on to our free play.**
- 11:15 am** **Free Play – Children will choose their own games and activities. There will be a variety of toys, games and activities available to the children geared toward enhancing their growth and development. If the weather permits, we will be outside!**
- 11:45 am** **Clean-Up Time – Toys are put away and hands are washed before lunch**
- 12:00 pm** **Lunch**
- 12:30 pm** **Clean-Up Time – Children get ready for rest time.**
- 12:45 pm** **Story Time**
- 1:00 pm** **Rest Time – all children are given a rest period.**
- 2:30 pm** **Nap/Quiet Play – Those Children who have no fallen asleep by this time may play quietly. There are books, puzzles, educational games and a variety of toys available for quiet play.**
- 3:00 pm** **Afternoon Snack**
- 3:45 pm** **Afternoon activity – this will be time for kids to do sensory activities or music/dancing time.**
- 4:15 pm** **Free Play – Children will choose their own games and activities. We may go outside also**
- 4:44 pm** **Clean-Up Time - Toys are put away. Kids wash hands and faces before going home.**
